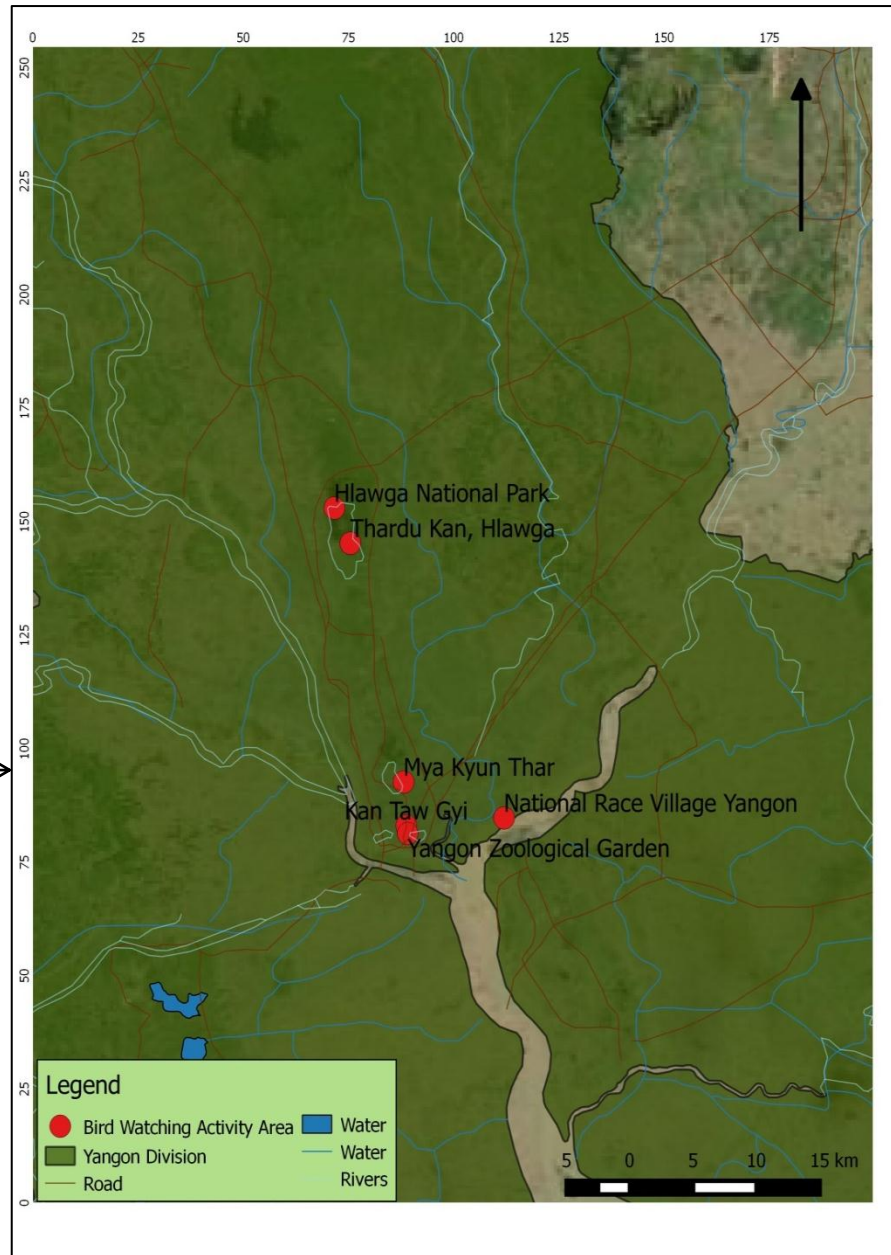
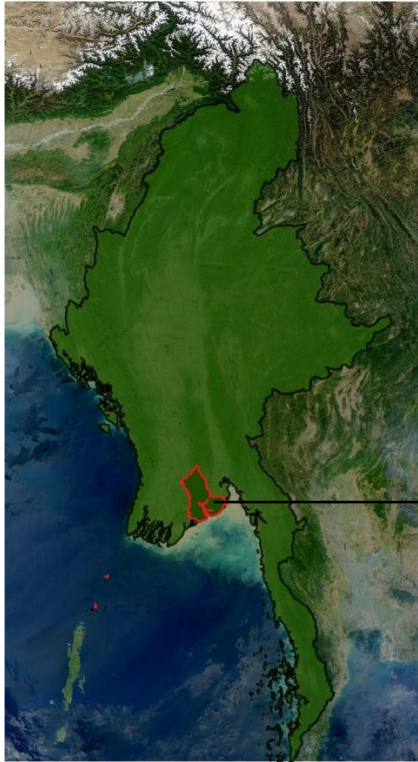

Site 1: National Races Village, Yangon**Date:** 29 October 2017**Address:** National Races Village, Yangon. Yandar Roadd, Thanlyin Bridge, Let Tamar Quarter, Thakayta Township, Yangon.**Location:** N 16°48'10.81" E 96°13'50.17"

Site Description: Traditional houses of the Kachin, Kayah, Kayin, Chin, Bamar, Mon, Rakhine and Shan are dotted around this lush, landscaped compound hugging the Bago River, just north of the Yangon side of the Thanlyin Bridge. At the National Races Village in Thaketa Township near Thanlyin Bridge can be easily to get acquainted with Myanmar's cultural diversity. Dubbed the "People's Zoo" by locals, it is segmented according to states from Mon to Kayah, and comprises traditional houses of the country's eight major ethnic groups. Visitors may wander through the houses to discover the various crafts, ethnic clothes, and tools of Myanmar's indigenous people. Myanmar's indigenous tribes may be largely located in isolated regions, but that does not mean that they are inaccessible to travellers who do not have the time to venture farther afield. The village is part of a lush park that's also home to a beautiful lake, a crocodile farm and a bird sanctuary. It can be explored by bicycle – rent one at the park's entrance. There is also a playground and miniaturized landmarks such as Mount Zwegabin (the tallest mountain in Hpa-An), along with the heart-shaped Reed Lake in Chin State.

Observation of bird species: A total of 32 species of 28 genera and 23 families of bird were recorded.

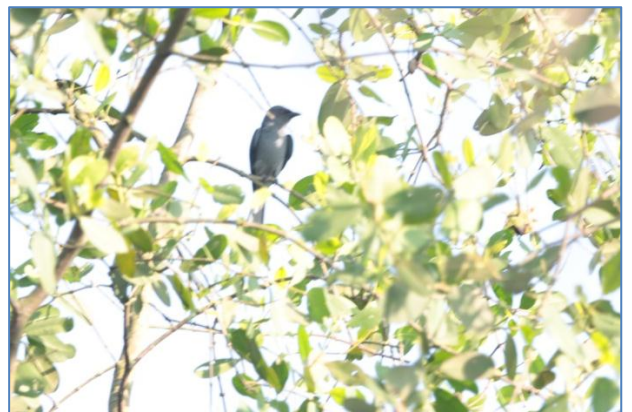

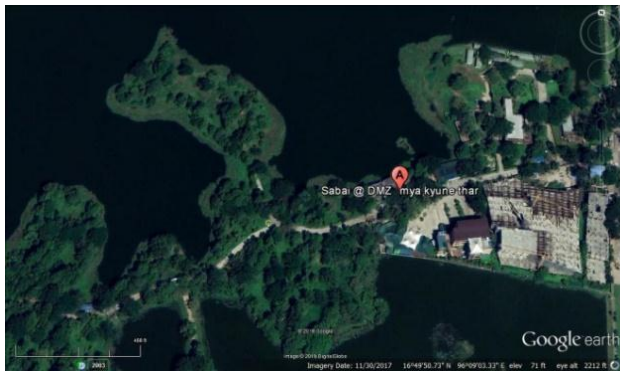

Site Description: Hlawga National Park is a located in Mingaladon, Yangon Division, Myanmar, 22 miles (35 km) north of Yangon. 1540-acres (623-hectare) park includes an 818-acre (313 hectare) wildlife park, 62-acre (25-hectare) mini-zoo and a 660-acre (267-hectare) buffer zone. Driving time to the park from Yangon is minimum one hour despite being only 27km. Wildlife-wise can be seen variety of bird species, deer, wild pigs and water buffalo. In addition to the lake-loop, Hlawga also has a mini-zoo

Observation of bird species: A total of 45 species of 36genera and 19 families of bird were recorded.

Site 4: Kandawgyi Garden

Address: Kandawgyi Garden or Kandawgyi Nature Park is located on Natmauk Road and Kandawgyi Kanpat Road.

Location: N16 °47'51.76" E96 °09'29.87"

Site Description: Kandawgyi Park is 260 acres wide (the garden area is 110 acres and water area is 150 acres. The Kandawgyi lake placidly reflect the sky changing colour with the time of the day. and the golden spire the Shwe Dagon Pagoda over the tops of the green wood's lining its banks. Kandawgyi Garden or Kandawgyi Nature Park is one of the tourist attractions of Yangon. Kandawgyi meaning "the great lake" in Myanmar is a popular recreation centre in Yangon.). Kandawgyi Garden or Kandawgyi Nature *Park* is a popular recreation centre of the capital of Yangon. Can be seen a variety of beautiful flowers, the natural scene of the lake water and large shady trees. There are also Kandawgyi Lake is one of two major lakes in Yangon, Burma (Myanmar). Located east of the Shwedagon Pagoda, the lake is artificial; water from Inya Lake is channeled through a series of pipes to Kandawgyi Lake.

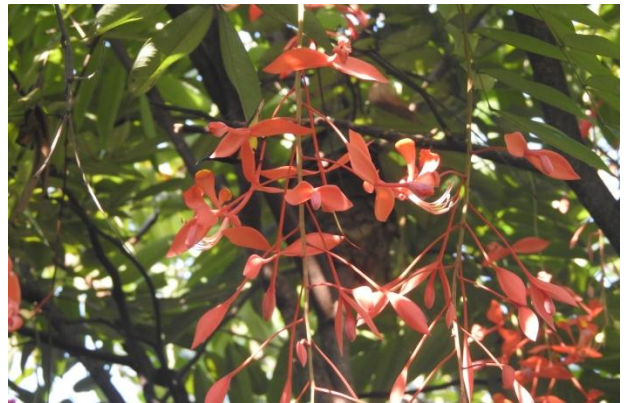

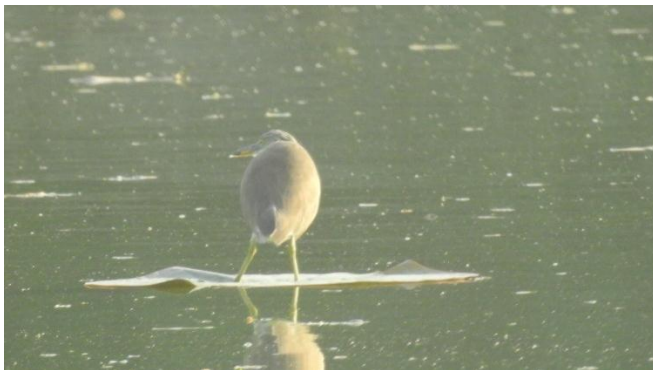

Address: Located immediately north of downtown Yangon near Kandawgyi Lake.

Location: N16 ° 47'32.34"E96° 09'33.54"

Site Description: The Yangon Zoological Garden (Yangon Zoo) is the oldest and the second largest zoo in Myanmar and located immediately north of downtown Yangon near Kandawgyi Lake, the 70-acre (28 ha) recreational park also includes

a museum of natural history, an aquarium and an amusement park with a collection of nearly 200 species and 1100 animals, the zoo draws nearly 2.2 million visitors annually. The zoo was operated by the Forest Department under the Ministry of Forestry until April 2011, and is now operated by a private firm.

Observation of bird species: A total of 19 species of 15 genera and 11 families of bird were recorded.

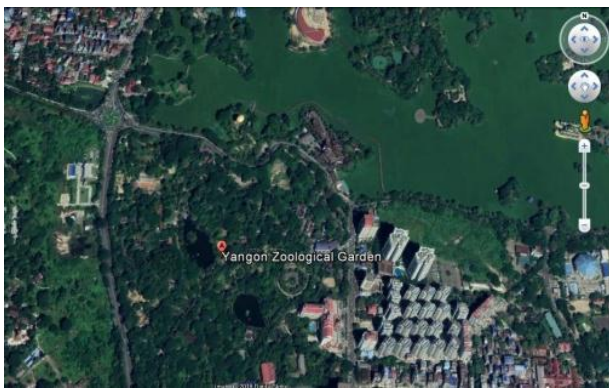
